022/17 Apologies

Apologies were noted from Councillors R. Banks and T. Bounds.

#### 023/17 Declarations of Interests and requests for dispensation

# 024/17 Minutes of the meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2017

# 025/17 Resurfacing of the Children's Play Area

This item was deferred until the next meeting pending receipt of a paper by the Management Group outlining the discussions that had taken place in identifying a preferred contractor and refining the quotation. Members noted the need to move quickly on this as the surface has deteriorated raising safety concerns.

#### 026/17 Cottage Repairs

It was noted that the advertisement for a preferred contractor which had appeared in the Recreation Ground had only generated one response. After some discussion, it was agreed that the Clerk be authorised to instruct surveyor David Walters to prepare recommendations and a specification for repair work for the Cottage at an estimated cost of £100.00. The specification will be reviewed by the Trust at the next meeting with a view to seeking quotes from builders for the work.

# 027/17 Groundsman Vacancy

It was agreed that a formal recruitment process should be carried out to replace the Groundsman upon his retirement at the end of August. It was further agreed to request that this be handled by the Town Council's Personnel Committee in accordance with Town Council procedures.
