4 Applications under permitted development rights

Members requested that the clerk approaches Herefordshire Council to request that a replacement tree be provided by the applicant.

Plan 076-21 7 Status of S106 Funds held by Herefordshire Council

Members noted that funds appear to be outstanding for a period in excess of ten years from developments in Kington, although investigations from some years ago did suggest that the recording of expenditure by Herefordshire Council might be inaccurate. As a general rule, s106 funding not spent with a period of ten years can be reclaimed by the developer so it is unclear whether any of the balances indicated as remaining are available for project within the town. It was agreed that this should be investigated further and in particular to link any remaining funding with the projects identified in the Economic Development Plan where appropriate.
