 6 Update on application 181494, Land adjacent to Spring Cottage, Headbrook
 Members noted the report from Cllr. Fitton who had attended on behalf of the
 Town Council and had spoken at the meeting, outlining the Town Council's
 comments on this application. It was further noted that consent has been
 granted by Herefordshire Council for outline permission for 35 houses, 35% of
 which are to be affordable. Members of the public in attendance at the meeting
 expressed concern about the environmental impact of the proposed
 development on the river bank and the flood plain and thanked Cllr. Fitton for
 attending.

The s106 agreement detailed on the application website indicates an area of public open space which is to include an equipped play area for children, maintenance of which is through on going contributions from home owners with ownership and management of the public open space to be decided but potentially to be managed by the Town Council. Although it is unclear whether the site is now to be sold to developers, it was agreed to recommend to full council that a watching brief be kept on the potential public open space offer with a view to entering into discussions with the site owners/developers and that the Town Council engages with the next stage of the planning process for this site when details of the proposed development come forward for consideration.

Plan 047-23 7 Report on Training Session "What's New in Planning"

Members noted the materials provided by Cllr. Ruth Warne on a recent training session attended.

Plan 048-23 8 S106 Update

Cllr. Woolford reported that he will shortly attend a s106 briefing by the s106 delivery team of Balfour Beatty/Herefordshire Council and hoped to be briefed on the pedestrian crossing to be installed opposite the primary school and originally scheduled for installation a year ago.

Plan 049-23 9 Signage for Mortimer Trail

The Clerk explained that Kington Walks propose installing a sign for the Mortimer Trail on the wall of the Place de Marines and have been advised by Herefordshire Council Planning Department regarding permissions required for this work. The Town Council has been invited to apply for a Certificate of Lawfulness for this installation. It was agreed to defer this to the next full council meeting and in the meantime to request sight of the design and layout of the proposed installation.
