6 078-24 Public Participation

a) Police report

It was noted that representatives from West Mercia Police were unable to attend the meeting but had provided a brief written report which was read out by the clerk.

b) Ward Councillor report

Members noted the verbal report from Ward Councillor Terry James which included reference to notice being served by Herefordshire Council to cancel the contract with public realm contractors Balfour Beatty. Proposals for how public realm will be managed at the end of the contract period is unclear although one option might be for local contractors to be used wherever possible. It was also reported that the financial situation at Herefordshire Council is better than many principal authorities nationally. A new interim Director of Children's Services has been appointed and will join the Council shortly.

14 086-24 Planning Matters

Members noted the submission to Herefordshire Council under the Local Plan Consultation as agreed at the last meeting has now been uploaded to the Herefordshire Council website.

15 087-24 Empty building on the High Street

It was noted that this matter had been requested by a member of the public and business owner on the High Street and involved concerns at the poor state of the building and alleged activities taking place there. The matter was deferred to the next meeting but it was also noted by the Ward Councillor that he had been in discussions with the property owners regarding this property.

16 088-24 Update on Christmas Lights 2024

Cllr. R. Banks updated members on current negotiations with potential suppliers of Christmas lights. A proposal will be put to the June meeting of the Town Council.

17 089-24 Public Rights of Way Funding

It was noted that following an announcement of additional funding for public rights of way it was currently unclear whether this funding is to be made available to those parishes who are not members of the Lengthsman Scheme. This agenda item was therefore deferred until the funding is clearer but in the meantime it was agreed that this be included in matters to be discussed with Herefordshire Council's Chief Executive.

18 090-24 Rural Services Network

It was agreed to renew the Town Council's membership of the Rural Market Town Group of the Rural Services Network at a cost of £100.00 (+VAT) for the year.

19 091-24 Rural Small Towns Study

Following an approach from the University of Leicester, it was agreed that Cllrs. J. Gardner, M. Fitton, P. Sell, R. Warne and M. Woolford be authorised to represent the Town Council in an academic study of Rural Small Towns.

20 092-24 D-Day Celebrations

A report from Kington Chamber of Trade on D-Day celebrations was noted. In particular members were reminded of remembrance service at the War Memorial on Sunday 2nd June commencing with a parade to the War Memorial from the Market Hall for the 11am service. There will also be a lighting of the beacon at the Golf Club on June 6th and displays and a ratio book trail in the town through the period.

21 093-24 Reports from Councillors

The following items were noted during this agenda item:

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- A request for British Telecom to repair two public telephone boxes in Kington that are in a poor state of repair
- A request that the public realm contractor sweeps the Place de Marine regularly
- A request that public artwork be display on scaffolding erected by Herefordshire Council by the public toilets
- A request that if or when a tree is felled that consideration be given to using the wood for a sculpture or artwork
- A request for the former toll house at Headbrook, located within Lyonshall Parish, be repaired.

KINGTON TOWN COUNCIL Meeting to be held on Monday 13th May 2024 Clerk's Report

This report identifies activities of the Clerk since the last meeting other than those addressed elsewhere on the agenda or addressed by other Members as part of their report and includes some items which are for information only.

1. Kington Transport Study

We are still awaiting sight of the Kington Transport Study for Kington. Herefordshire Council is currently conducting a consultation/survey into travel patterns as part of the larger Herefordshire Transport Study and members, and members of the public, are encouraged to submit their own responses to this plan. The Clerk recently met with Herefordshire Council's Head of Highways and Transport and reiterated the request by the Town Council as key stakeholder in this project for input into the Kington Transport Study proposals.

2. Community Infrastructure Fund

Herefordshire Council has announced the launch of the Community Infrastructure Fund which is a capital fund designed to:

- Strengthen our social fabric and foster a sense of local pride and belonging
- Build pride in place and increase life chances in our local communities
- Build resilient and safe neighbourhoods
- Creation and improvements to local rural green spaces
- Provide improved facilities which reduce the need for people to travel to access recreational facilities

If members would like to put forward a project for consideration using this funding, please let the clerks know so this can be added to the agenda for the next meeting. The deadline for completing projects with this funding is March 2025. However expressions of interest must be submitted by 3rd June.

Kington Economic Development Plan

At a recent meeting of the Market Town Clerks, Herefordshire Council's Service Director for Economy and Growth announced that work will shortly begin on a feasibility study for delivery of aspects of the Market Town's Economic Development Plans with the emphasis on delivery of employment land in the first instance. The Town Council is to be invited to participate in this work and will receive details shortly.

Financial year end

The internal audit process for the Town Council has now taken place with some areas identified for improvement, as expected. The report will be presented to the next meeting of the Finance, Personnel and General Purposes Committee later this month with a view to presenting to Full Council in due course. In the meantime a provisional date for the exercise of electors right to view the accounts and supporting papers has been set to start on **Monday 10**th **June**. The final Annual Governance and Accounting Return with supporting

papers will be presented to full council for approval at the meeting scheduled for Monday 3rd June 2024.

5. Herefordshire Council's Local Plan consultation

A reminder that the deadline for submission of comments on the proposals for Kington contained with Herefordshire Council's Local Plan is **Monday May 20**th.

6. Herefordshire Waste Services Webinar

Herefordshire Waste Services are holding an online webinar outlining changes to the waste service in Herefordshire. The event will take place online on **Tuesday 25th June from 12.45 – 14.00**. If members would like to attend, please let the clerk know so a booking can be made for you. Places are limited.

7. Financial Regulations

Financial regulations govern how the Town Council manages its finances and includes procedures for obtaining quotations, how expenditure is managed, how the budget process works, what records are kept and how decision making involving the expenditure of public money takes place. Many of these requirements are based in legislation whilst some have some flexibility so can be adapted to meet the needs of the local authority. Kington Town Council has adopted financial regulations which are based upon a model devised by the National Association of Local Councils and these have remained the same for some years. The National Association (NALC) has now released a new model set although as the Town Council is not a member of NALC, we are not entitled to access that model document. It does, however, remind all local councils that a revisit of the adopted regulations periodically is a good thing so the Finance, Personnel and General Purposes Committee will be discussing this at their next meeting.
