Members noted that Herefordshire Council has secured limited funding which they intend using to engage consultants to prepare a feasibility study into a project or projects identified within the Kington Economic Development plan which itself was commissioned by Herefordshire Council and adopted by them in 2021. Taking the project priorities identified within the Plan, members discussed each of the projects noting many of which had been completed or partially completed by the Town Council in conjunction with Herefordshire Council or others over the past few years. After due consideration, the following three projects were identified as priorities for further investigation by Herefordshire Council consultants with a view to preparing a feasibility study:

- Additional car parking provision within the town to attract visitors to shops, businesses and events and to provide parking for those living or working in the Town. Signage on the approaches to the town to support this work was also suggested.
- Possible relocation of the Fire Station and Police Station to an alternative, possibly shared, location to enhance response times and release land for car parking and/or housing.
- Development of the Market Hall and surrounds to improve the visual amenity of the Town Centre, attract visitors and provide improved facilities for markets, festivals and events.

The Clerk was instructed to pass this to Herefordshire Council.
