- b) Provision for young people
The committee discussed the Youth Strategy proposals from Herefordshire Council. Concerns were raised about the financial contribution that was required and the support that would be provided to Kington young people, based on the model identified by Herefordshire Council.
RESOLVED: That the Youth Strategy proposals be added to the next Full Council agenda.
- c) Public toilets
The Committee noted the possibility of taking on responsibility of the toilets situated at the Market Hall. Work is being undertaken by Herefordshire Council and is due for completion in November 2026.
Information is still required from Herefordshire Council in regards to the building and associated freeholds, Rights of Way and other areas for consideration.
There will need to be more detailed specifications prior to ownership being undertaken.
The Chamber of Trade have been engaged in the conversations on this subject.
RESOLVED: That Full Council convene a multi-institutional Working Party to develop a strategy for the acquisition of the toilet and lead on this report to Full Council, with a reporting line to the Finance Committee.

It was reported that the Tourist Information Centre continues to operate successfully.
