Plan 013-20 7 S106 Agreements

The Clerk outlined the background to section 106 agreements and in particular discussions that had taken place at the Market Towns Forum with Herefordshire Council regarding s106 projects. It was noted in particular that Herefordshire Council's planning department, who negotiate s106 agreements, are looking for advice on Town and Parish Council's s106 funding requirements at the point where planning applications are in the public domain for comments/observations, which means that some project planning is needed prior to any application being considered.

A senior planning officer is to discuss this with each of the Market Towns in the near future but in the meantime it was agreed that a working party would be formed to look into potential projects further and present a report to the planning committee in due course.
